Completed Legal Commitments to Date:

- Study of the needs for knowledge transfer from Universities to businesses
- Construction of the Operations Manual (toolbox) of Liaison Offices
- Creation of an instruction manual as a source for the provision of specialized consultancy services from Universities to the Industry

Completed Legal Commitments to Date:

- Development of educational material for promoting entrepreneurial culture
- Implementation of a study on an institutional framework and procedures for protection of intellectual property and patents

Legal Commitments under implementation:

- Operating six (6) Industry Liaison Offices, 5 with full human resources in place
- Development of a shared web portal and data base
- Quality Assurance Management of the Project
- Creation of academic and businesses research profiles
- Development and production of information material and publicity actions

Main Outcomes completed to Date

- The operating five Industry Liaison Offices, managed to place 15 students in businesses
- Dissemination and Promotion Website
 (www.liaisonoffices.ac.cy), periodic airing of two radio spots,
 participation in conferences /workshops/meetings, contact with
 Industry entities, 3 newsletters published
- 40% of the academic profiles of all universities is completed
- 111 business profiles collected and completed from all over Cyprus
